July 1. *The Bourne Ultimatum* is the final installment in the Robert Ludlum series featuring the government's most wanted amnesiac spy, Jason Bourne. Rated PG-13.

July 8. *The Hours* employs Virginia Woolf's classic novel and central character, Mrs. Dalloway, as its inspiration, starring Nicole Kidman, Meryl Streep, and Julianne Moore. Rated PG-13.

July 15. *Hotel Rwanda*. This historical drama documents one man's efforts to save the lives of his family and more than a thousand other refugees, by granting them shelter in a besieged hotel. Rated PG-13.

July 22. *Coraline* uses vivid stop-motion animation combined with an imaginative story to create a film that's both visually stunning and wondrously entertaining. Rated PG.

July 29. *When We Were Kings* is a documentary film about the famous "Rumble in the Jungle" heavyweight championship match between Muhammad Ali and George Foreman. Rated PG.
