

## **Compatibility**

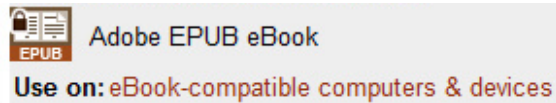
The number of eReaders seems to grow every month and while Library2Go content is compatible with most devices that recognize PDF and EPUB formats, as well as the Amazon Kindle, it is always best to check before you buy.

To check compatibility visit the L2G website and look at the **Getting Started** box on the left and choose **Compatible eBook Devices**.

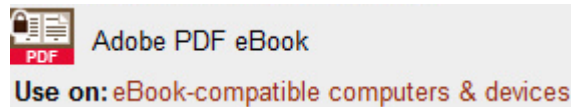
## **Formats**

Both eBook formats employed by Library2Go are built around Adobe formats, most with digital copy protection. It is generally a broadly compatible type. Kindle compatible titles are also available with fulfillment through Amazon.

**Adobe EPUB eBooks:** EPUB files are enhanced digital versions of print books. The EPUB format lets readers adjust the font and size settings of an eBook and allows for reformatting to fit the device's screen. The EPUB format is not supported by the Amazon Kindle.



**Adobe PDF eBooks:** PDF eBooks are digital versions of print books. The PDF format preserves the original formatting which makes it better for including images or charts; however it is not as customizable as the EPUB format. The Adobe PDF format is not supported by the Amazon Kindle.



**Amazon Kindle:** As you would imagine, this is the format you will need if you want to transfer to a Kindle or a device that uses the Kindle reader app.



## **Required Software**

Adobe Digital Editions is needed to read and transfer L2G titles. This is a free download. An Adobe ID is also required to activate your computer and device if you want to be able to complete the transfer process. You may already have an Adobe ID if you have ever registered one of their products such as Photoshop or Premier, or downloaded an official demo. If so, you may use this ID and password for Digital Editions. **Kindle** users *do not* need additional software.

## **eBook tips**

You can set your default lending period by logging into Library2Go and clicking **2Go Account** and then choose **Lending Periods**. You can set individual defaults for every L2G format. These defaults are what the mobile application uses when checking out.

Titles can be returned early in ADE and the mobile app.

In ADE click the small dropdown in the lower right of the title's thumbnail view in the library and chose **Return**.

In the app open the title and then choose **Delete**. You will be given the options to Delete, Return and Delete or Cancel. Choose Return and the title is checked-in, removing it from your checked out titles and making room for more.

## **Mobile App**

If you want to take your eBook with you, or if you want to download a book on the go without a computer, you can download the OverDrive Media Console Mobile App for your smartphone. The app is compatible with Apple iOS, Android, BlackBerry, Windows Mobile 5 & 6 devices as well as Windows Phone 7.

From your device you can download eBooks wirelessly and without OverDrive installed on your home computer.

At this time you are only allowed to have a title on one computer or device at a time. Therefore you couldn't checkout an eBook and download it to your phone and computer and listen to, or read it, in both places.
