- Download and install Adobe Digital Editions
 - Activate ADE
 - Download eBooks
 - Transfer eBooks to a reader device
 - Eject device
 - Return a title early

In order to read downloaded eBooks on your computer and to transfer to an eReader device, (except Amazon Kindle, Sony WiFi Reader 2011+) you will need Adobe Digital Editions, a free software utility. Download it from Adobe.com or the link on the Library2Go page.

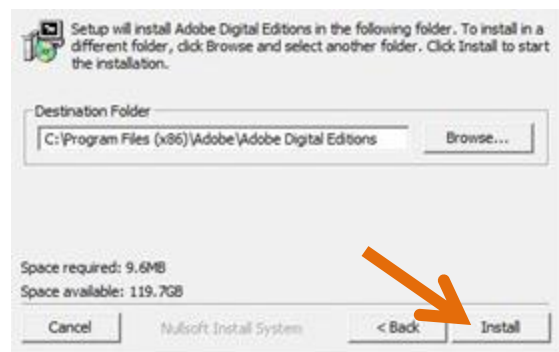
1. Click on **Adobe Digital Editions** in the Software box on the lower left.



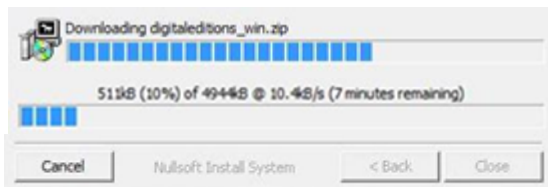
2. Scroll down and click **Install**. The download will connect. Click **Yes**.



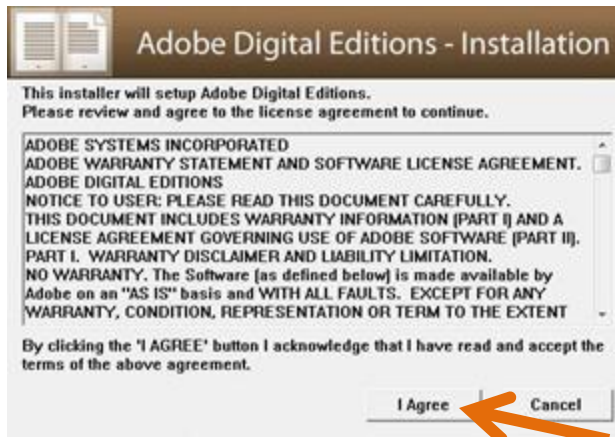
3. Click **Next** and **Install**.



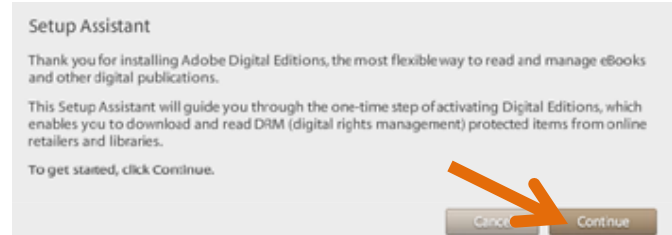
4. Digital Editions will then download and install. Click **Close** when the download completes.



5. Digital Editions will now launch. Read through the agreement and choose **I Agree** if you wish to continue.

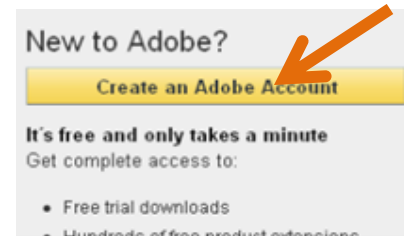
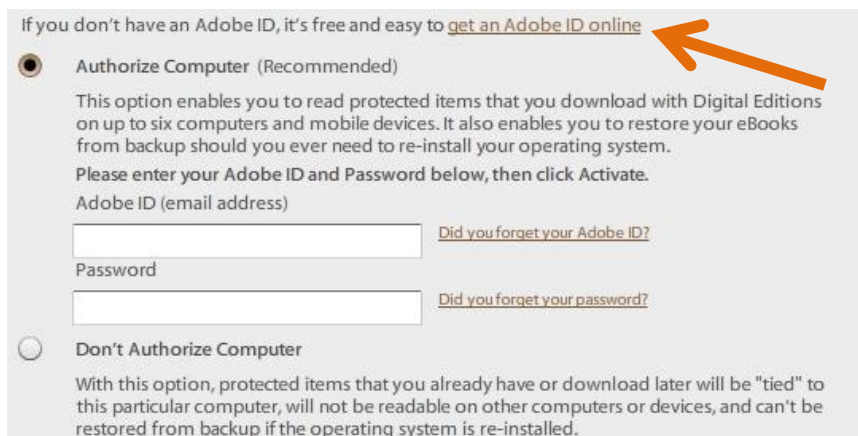

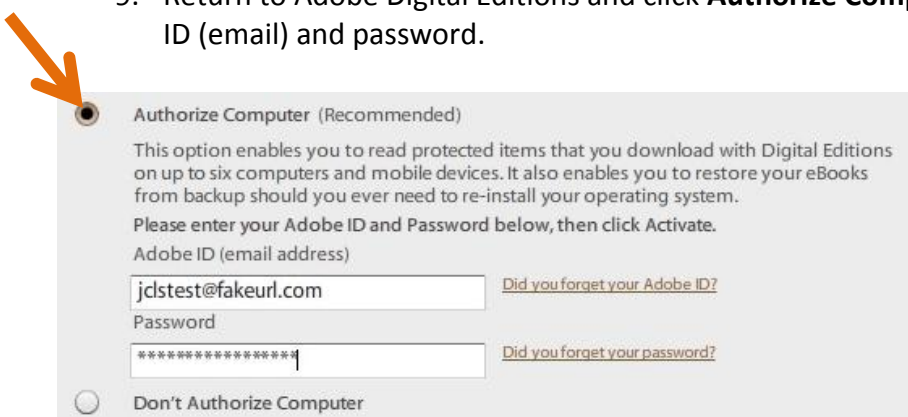
6. On the next screen click **Continue**.

7. Next you need to authorize your copy of Digital Editions for full functionality. To do this you need an Adobe ID. If you do not have an Adobe ID click on **get an Adobe ID online** (indicated by arrow). This will launch your web browser and redirect you to the Adobe web page where you can create an Adobe ID.



8. Click on **Create an Adobe Account**. Fill out the form that follows and click **Continue** at the bottom of the page.

9. Return to Adobe Digital Editions and click **Authorize Computer**, then enter your Adobe ID (email) and password.

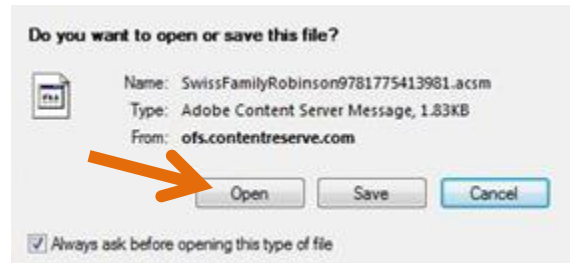
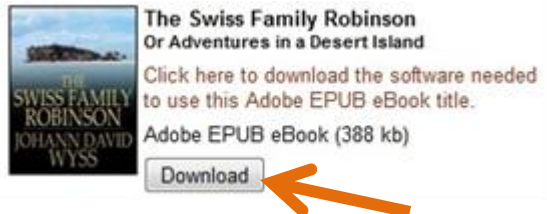


10. Click **Activate** to complete the setup. (Should you ever wish to de-authorize Adobe Digital Editions, you can do so by holding down Control, Shift and D.)

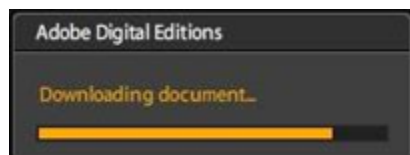
Downloading eBooks and Transferring Titles

After checking out an eBook you will arrive at the download page. Here's how you download titles and transfer them to an eReader.

11. Click the **Download** button under a title. Choose **Open**.



12. Digital Editions should automatically launch after the file is opened. The download will then commence in Digital Editions.



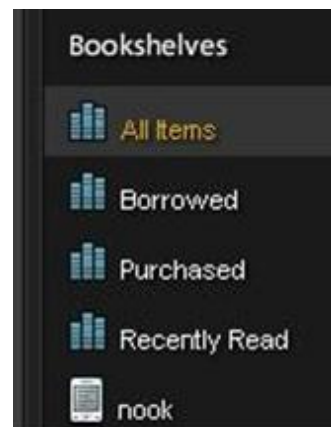

13. When the download completes the title may open automatically. Switch from Reading View to the **Library View** with the icon in the top left of the screen.

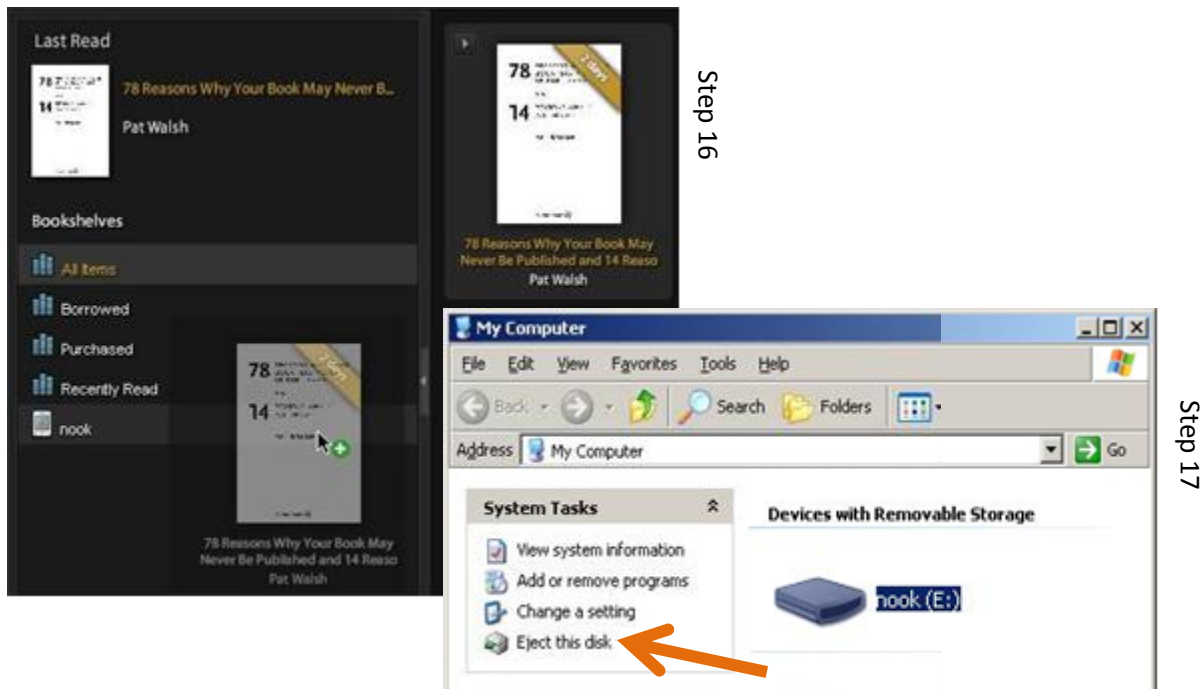
14. To transfer to an eReader, plug in your device. If the Windows launcher loads, click **Cancel**. Your eReader should appear in the Bookshelves pane in Digital Editions.



15. If this is the first time you have transferred and eBook, you will need to authorize the device using the same Adobe ID for Digital Editions and your reader. Click **Authorize Device** to do so.



16. To transfer an eBook to your reader, click and drag the book cover to your device (in the lower left corner of the screen) and release it to make the transfer.



17. Don't forget to eject your device before disconnecting it, click the safely remove hardware icon in the Windows system tray (green checkmark icon, bottom right, by the clock). Or open **My Computer**, highlight your device and click **Eject** this disc from the System Tasks pane.

18. To return a title early, open Digital Editions, hover over the arrow next to the title and click **Return Borrowed Item**. Click **Return** to confirm. The title has now been returned, it will automatically disappear from your library.
