"School for Skeptics" at the Eagle Point Branch Library

Many people are skeptical about topics such as UFOs and Big Foot, and yet there is a fascination that keeps these subjects in the media and as popular points for argument and ridicule. The "Thursday at the Library" series will feature two authorities on these very matters in the Eagle Point Branch Library's Community Room, 239 West Main Street, in April. These events are sponsored by the Eagle Point Friends of the Library.

On Thursday, April 2 from 4:00-5:30 p.m., Art Campbell, retired educator, high school counselor and administrator, will be speaking on "The UFO Crash at San Augustin." Most have heard about the Roswell incident of July 7, 1947. Mr. Campbell has evidence of a similar crash in New Mexico earlier that month. He has spent 12 years researching the site and has artifacts to share. There will be a historical review, along with a video of the San Augustin site and Mr. Campbell's work there. Mr. Campbell, who has appeared on *The History Channel*, has written a book on the topic.

On Thursday, April 16 from 4:00-5:30 p.m., Doug Devine of Pacific Survey Supply, will discuss his experience with the filming of *Sasquatch: Legend Meets Science*. On the heels of his successful collaboration on the recovery of the Civil War submarine, the *H.L. Hunley*, Mr. Devine joined in the scientific exploration for evidence of the existence of Sasquatch. This is an opportunity to see the original film taken in the Marble Mountain Wilderness of Northern California of an unidentified creature, often referred to as Big Foot. This incident was witnessed and filmed by a Campus Life group in July of 2000. Mr. Devine has been involved with forensic analysis of film evidence and sightings of unidentified creatures for numerous television production companies, including *National Geographic* and *The Discovery Channel*.

On display in the branch during this month will be a vintage *Star Wars* collection and photography from the Hubble telescope. The featured artist for the month will be Bruce Rawles and his "Classic Geometry Constructions."
