

How To Use the Library2Go App for Android

MP3 and EPUB

1. Visit the App Marketplace and download and install the **OverDrive Media Console**.



Or you can scan the barcode to download.

2. The first time you launch the OverDrive app, press the menu key and tap **Get Books**. Then tap **Add a Website** and search for “Jackson County Library Services”. (If the search fails you can use the **Browse for Libraries** function. Search United States> Oregon> Jackson County Library Services.) On the details page for JCLS, tap the star to save the website.
3. To search for titles to check out, go back to the **Get Books** page and tap **Oregon Digital Library Consortium** to be taken to the Library2Go page. Only titles compatible with your device will be displayed.
 - When you find a title you want to check out, tap **Add2Go Cart**. When you are done browsing tap **Proceed to Checkout**.
 - When checking out, choose **Jackson County Library Services** and enter your library card number at the prompts.
 - At the check out screen, tap **Confirm checkout**.
4. From your checkouts, tap **Download** and complete action using **Browser**; the title will now load into your library. If you are checking out an Adobe protected e-book you will be required to activate an Adobe ID for your device before viewing your book. To do this return to the Library window. Press the Menu key and tap **App Settings**. Under **eBook Options** you will see a box for your Adobe ID, enter your information and your device will be activated. (To obtain an Adobe ID follow the link in eBook options.)
5. Your title should now appear in your library. Before you can listen to an Audiobook, your title needs to be downloaded to your device. From the Library screen, tap the title and tap **Yes** to download now. (Be aware that Audiobooks can be quite large, make sure your data plan allows for this much usage, for better speeds it is generally best to download over a WiFi connection.)
