

# How to use the Library2Go App on iOS

MP3 and EPUB

1. Visit the App Store and search for “Overdrive”, the app you are looking for is the **Overdrive Media Console**. After finding it tap **Free**, then tap **Install**. You may have to enter your Apple ID password to continue.
2. After the app installs, launch it from the home screen and tap the **Get Books +** button (top right). On the next screen tap **Add a Website**. Search for “Jackson County Library Services” or enter your zip code and tap your branch. In the branch details page tap **Oregon Digital Library Consortium (ODLC)**. The link opens in Safari and takes you to the Library2Go mobile site. You will probably want to bookmark this page for future use.
3. In future to search the Library2Go catalog, just tap the **Get Books+** button and select ODLC to browse available titles. Only those compatible with your device will be displayed.
  - When you have searched for and added titles into your cart, tap **Proceed To Checkout**.
  - Choose “**Jackson County Library Services**” and enter your library card number at the prompts.
  - At the checkout screen tap **Confirm Check Out**.
4. Download the title you have chosen. If this is your first download, activation with an Adobe ID is required in order to read DRM protected Adobe eBooks. Go to the **Get Books+** tab and tap **Settings**. Tap **Authorize with Adobe ID**. Now enter your Adobe ID information and tap authorize. (To obtain an Adobe ID tap the link at the bottom of the page to go create an Adobe account.)
  - **Note:** You may already have an Adobe ID if you have ever registered an Adobe product such as Acrobat, Photoshop or Premier.
5. Now you may read your downloaded books. Tap the title to open the book, tap the edges of the screen to turn pages or tap the book title at the top of the screen for more options. For audiobooks tap the title, choose **Download**, and use the player controls for playback.

## **iPad Tips and Tricks**

### **Hidden Keyboard Characters**

Hold or swipe up on the comma and period keys for apostrophes and quotations. Double tapping the space key automatically inserts a period.

### **Multi-Tasking**

Double tap the home button to bring up the multi-task window. From here you can close running apps by tapping and holding the icons until they wiggle, then tap the red circles on the icons. You can also launch a running app by tapping it. Swiping left-to-right will also bring up the music controls, brightness bar and screen orientation lock.

### **Screenshots**

Press the home button and the sleep/wake button simultaneously to take a screenshot. Pictures are saved in Photos.

### **Bypass Syncing in iTunes**

If you want to bypass iTunes synchronizing with the iPad once, press and hold Shift-Control (Windows) while plugging the device in. iTunes will then skip the sync one time.

### **Spotlight (that is, how to search)**

From the home screen swipe left to bring up the searchlight page, here you may search for applications, files and emails.

### **Maps Tips**

Google Maps displays in brilliant edge-to-edge detail, but peel back the page in the bottom right edge of the screen for more view options, even turn on traffic mapping in supported areas.

### **Web Page Video Viewing**

Right now iOS lacks Flash support, some videos therefore won't play at all, but for those that do, double tap them for a full screen view, pinch the screen to reduce the size again.

### **Moisture**

Don't expose the iPad to high moisture or humidity as the displays have a record of shorting out in damp conditions and it is not covered by the factory warranty.
