Downloadable E-Books Available in Jackson County Libraries March 15

Beginning March 15, Jackson County Library users will have access to e-book titles 24/7. Through the Library2Go link on Jackson County Library Services' Web site ([www.jcls.org](http://www.jcls.org)), card holders can browse the collection, checkout, and download e-books, audiobooks, and videos, anytime, anywhere.

"Downloadable e-books are growing in popularity and we are excited to offer this new format in addition to thousands of audiobooks and videos currently available," said Kim Wolfe, Medford Library Manager. "The Library2Go consortium has purchased hundreds of best-selling and classic titles, all of which can be read on your computer or compatible reading device."

Downloadable e-books can be read on a PC or Mac using free reader software called Adobe Digital Editions. They can also be transferred to popular electronic-reading devices like the Sony Reader and the Barnes & Noble nook. The Sony Reader and the nook are designed to look and feel like a book and are great for users on the go.

To checkout e-books, audiobooks, and videos, users need a valid JCLS library card, computer, and Internet connection. Once downloaded, digital media can be enjoyed on a computer and transferred to popular devices such as MP3 players, iPods, smartphones, and more. At the end of the lending period, titles automatically expire and are returned to the collection. Users may return e-books early.

Oregon Digital Library Consortium (ODLC) partners with OverDrive, Inc. ([www.overdrive.com](http://www.overdrive.com)), a global leader in digital media services, to offer the Library2Go service. ODLC was formed in 2005, with the purpose of delivering electronic resources, such as downloadable audiobooks, video, and e-books, to participating libraries statewide.
